St. Margaret's COVID-19 Precautions

- All services will continue to be live-streamed via our Facebook and YouTube pages, so if you are unable to celebrate Mass in person, you will still be able to participate from home.
- All surfaces will be sanitized once a week after 10:00 AM Mass on Sunday. This includes door knobs, doors, restrooms, and chairs.
- All Ushers and Eucharistic Ministers will be trained to aid parishioners in observing social distancing during Communion.

What We ask of Congregants

- If you are or have been exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 or have been exposed to the virus in the last 14 days, please refrain from attending Mass in person.
- Check your temperature before coming to Mass. If you are running a fever, please refrain from attending Mass in person.
- If you have an underlying health condition, or are in the 60+ age range, we encourage you to continue celebrating Mass at home.
- If you are able to come to Mass in person, you **MUST** wear a mask at all times while you are in the building. (Unless you have a medical excuse that is approved by Jackson County Health Department guidelines.)
- While Social Distancing is no longer required by the Jackson County Health Department, we ask that you remain courteous of people around you. We encourage you to leave at least two chairs in between you and another family unit.
- During Mass, please listen and observe any and all instructions regarding the Communion procession and the proper way to receive the Blessed Sacrament. Sanitize your hands before approaching the minister. When you reach the minister, leave your mask on, receive the Sacrament in your hands, say "Amen," then move to the side, move your mask down, consume the Sacrament and replace your mask.
